Flash Flood Prediction Program

MESSAGE 1'S CONTINUE VALID/THREAT FOR HEAVY RAINFALL FROM THUNDERSTORMS HAS PASSED

- Message 1's will continue valid until 10:00 PM this evening although the threat for heavy rainfall from thunderstorms has passed.
- Now that temperatures have cooled into the 40's over the District a more stratiform rain has developed. Widespread rain showers currently blanket the area with rainfall rates generally in the 0.2-0.6"/hr range. A strong and persistent rain shower may result in rainfall rates reaching 1"/hr which could still result in excessive runoff in isolated areas.
- The moisture today is much needed as May has been a fairly dry month for the District. Rainfall totals since this morning currently range from as little as 0.3" to as much as 1.4". An additional 0.3-1.4" or more of rain is likely to fall into the evening. Showers are expected to gradually diminish from NW to SE.

STORM RAINFALL POTENTIAL AND DURATION: Rain showers will typically produce rainfall rates of 0.1-0.6"/hr. A persistent moderate rain shower may produce up to 1.0" in 1hr.
