MESSAGE 1

Flash Flood Prediction Program

STREET FLOODING POTENTIAL

We have determined that street and small stream flooding is possible in the following counties:
Boulder (City of Boulder affected, Four Mile Burn Area affected), Jefferson, Broomfield, Adams, Denver

including: **DIA, Arvada, Wheat Ridge, Lakewood**

from: **Current** to **900 PM.**

Prime time for flooding: **Current** to **800 PM.**

Forecast rainfall: Moderate to strong thunderstorms will have the potential to produce 0.3-0.8" of rain in 10-30 minutes. A nearly stationary thunderstorm may result in up to 1.6" of rain in 60 minutes or less.

The most likely areas to be impacted by flooding are:

Urban streams/gulches; road crossings; recreational trails; adjacent open space areas/campgrounds/parks; floodplain properties; utilities

Urban streets, intersections, low lying areas, known trouble spots

Mountain locations subject to mud/rock/debris slide

Additional Information: **Strong thunderstorms may also contain large hail, gusty winds, frequent cloud-to-ground lightning.**
